Description:

In a central part of the village this converted winery, with its own little tower, offers 430 m2 living space comprising 3 bedrooms, large salon, large kitchen, dining room, office library and multiple utility and work spaces from the cleverly converted original wine vats, a courtyard and small terrace. This light-filled property has been renovated to make use of the space, but has retained its original character.

A number of the original elements from the winery have been incorporated into the renovation, including the use of the beautiful original wine press as support for the hand-commissioned staircase.

A charming octagonal tower and a small terrace overlook a central courtyard.

The house requires refurbishment, but makes excellent use of both space and light.

The wine vats have been opened up to make functional spaces, maximising space and use of the house.

The property could be used in two parts as there is both front and rear access and the heating system has been divided, therefore offering potential to create a gite or apartment for rental.



- Location: Pretty winegrowers village in the Minervois, with bar/restaurant, bakery, : at 10 minutes from Olonzac, 25 minutes from Carcassonne, 45 minutes from Narbonne, and less than an hour from beaches and Beziers (airport).

- Ground floor: Garage of 22.75 m² (double doors, stained glass feature to corridor, double access to corridor), corridor of 15 m² (glass brick window), bathroom of 5.4 m² (shower, basin, WC), library of 14.85 m² (sink, shelving, original stable features, beams, access to mezzanine with ladder access), salon of 19.25 m² (beams, double glazed), kitchen of 54.05 m² (wood burning stove, sink, work units), utility of 7.5 m² (original wine vat), 3 utility rooms of 7.5 m² each (original wine vats), WC of 7.5 m² (original wine vat), boiler room of 10.5 m² (original wine vat, De Dietrich boiler with 2 independent systems to heat either side of house), feature stairs (solid pine handmade stairs incorporating original wine press), courtyard of 22.45 m² (L shaped - tiled, planted with low maintenance bamboo).

- 1st floor: Lounge of 92.4 m² (open fireplace, tiled, Juliette balcony), mezzanine of 17.5 m² (exposed and sealed stone walls), mezzanine (semi triangular area 2 x 4.5 x 4.5m), veranda of 13.75 m², corridor of 6 m² (exposed beams, heat vent from wood stove), bedroom of 15 m² (L shaped), bedroom of 16.5 m² (heat vent from wood stove, balcony) with dressing of 6 m² and ensuite of 6 m² (WC, basin, bidet), bathroom of 4.25 m² (WC, basin, bath).

- 2nd floor: Bedroom (6.5 x 7 x 5 m, L shaped) with balcony of 6 m², tower (octangular, 360 °C views, exposed beams, roof light).

- Exterior: Courtyard of 22.45 m².

- Sundry: Main sewage and water, annual property tax around 3337 Euro, fuel central heating, wood burning stoves, good structural state, original features, partly double glazed, estimated amount of annual energy consumption for standard use: between 3371 Euro and 4561 Euro per year. Average energy prices indexed on 1st January 2021 (including subscriptions).
