Tortuga is a village in the central mountain range of Trinidad and Tobago – approximately 22 mi or (36 km) South of Port of Spain , the country's capital city. Tortuga, named after the multitude of turtles (morocoys) which roamed the landscape, is a small village approximately 10 sq. km in size. It was well-known as a thriving agricultural community with several groups contributing to its economic development.

Grande Riviere is a village on the north coast of Trinidad and Tobago. It is 100 km from the capital Port of Spain. It is accessible via a single paved road which runs from Toco (site of the island's only lighthouse) to its east, and is separated from the rest of the island by the hills of the Northern Range.

Trinidad and Tobago is a dual-island Caribbean nation near Venezuela, with distinctive Creole traditions and cuisines. Trinidad's capital, Port of Spain, hosts a boisterous carnival featuring calypso and soca music. Numerous bird species inhabit sanctuaries such as the Asa Wright Nature Centre. The smaller island of Tobago is known for its beaches and the Tobago Main Ridge Forest Reserve, which shelters hummingbirds.

Trinidad and Tobago is one of the wealthiest countries in the Caribbean, thanks to its large reserves of oil and gas, the exploitation of which dominates its economy. Inhabited mostly by people of African and Indian descent, the two-island state enjoys a per-capita income well above the average for Latin America and the Caribbean. Trinidad is the second largest leatherback nesting site in the world with some 6000 of these heavyweights travelling across the Atlantic to nest on the north and east coast every year from March to August. These leatherbacks can weigh up to 2000 lbs and be up to 10 ft in length.
