Detached stone house formerly built as an annex of the old chateau of the village (17th century) and renovated in 2000 and 2018, offering about 340 m² of living space including 4 large family suites including 4 bathrooms, all rooms facing a lovely south orientated courtyard of 150 m² with a hot tub. Comfortable all year round with a recent wooden pellet central heating system (2018). Peaceful with character and comfort in the heart of the historical centre of the village.

- Location: Lively village with all shops, bars, restaurants, primary and secondary schools, train station, 15 minutes from Beziers, 15 minutes from the A9 and A 75 motorways and 25 minutes from the coast.

- Ground floor: Equipped kitchen of 32 m² (hob, extractor, electric oven, sink, dishwasher), dining room of 22 m², lounge of 28 m² with access to another courtyard of 13.6 m² (leading to an independent room of 49 m² located on top of the lounge).

- 1st floor: En suite bedroom of 32 m² (bath, shower, 2 washbasins, independent wc), hall, washroom of 7 m² (shower, washbasin, wc), room/bedroom of 22 m² with access to a bedroom of 28 m² with access to a renovated room of 49 m² (ideal for an art gallery, workshop, gym, music studio etc:) and access to the small courtyard.
