which divides Kwa Zulu Natal from the (Transkei) and Eastern Cape. Umtamvuna View Cabanas has the feeling of tranquillity and remoteness due to its location but is within easy commuting distance to Port Edward town, shops, beach and the Wild Coast Casino as well as other well-known local attractions. If you need a piece of heaven to unwind and totally relax away from all the crowds, then this is the place for you. It's the perfect time to whisk your loved one away for a romantic getaway in a Cabana that is full of character with beautiful detail and breath-taking views to make you fall in love all over again.

Situated in the small holiday town of Port Edward on the Kwa Zulu Natal South coast, approximately 2 hours drive from Durban and 2 and half hours from Durban Airport

With stunning views of the River, Mountains and a slight sea view, enjoy a drink at the pool area and take in the beauty of the surrounding area. Birdlife and adjoining Nature reserve add to the peaceful and relaxing environment

This property is currently operating as a Self-Catering Guest house. Incorporating 5 x luxury Cabanas, (apartment) each of which includes the following: Stove, 4 plate electrical cooker, fridge, freezer, microwave, Dishwasher and a well-equipped kitchen with utensils and crockery etc. In addition, there is a large lounge suite, 40' flat screen TV, and satellite decoder with limited channels. There is a Queen bed and all linen and towels are included for each Cabana. There is security doors fitted to all windows and sliding doors. Each Cabana has its own Patio which overlooks a large communal pool and the amazing views of the mountains and more. The manager's residence consists of a 3-bedroom home which includes a recently remodelled kitchen and laundry plus a large external deck which is enclosed and offers a BBQ facility, a large lounge area plus a dining area. Views of the river and Mountains from this deck are absolutely stunning. The Main bedroom has a full ensuite bathroom plus and there is another bathroom with a shower for the guest rooms. The office/reception area is utilized as an office as well as a lounge area. This section can also easily be converted into additional guest residences with very little expense.

The total property size is 12164 sqm of which the building occupies approx—750 sqm under the roof. A large double garage is used by the owner / Manager while parking for the guests is available. There is a large pool situated on a large paved area which offers views from anywhere. There are 2 BBQ facilities located on the pool deck as well as a covered dining and seating area. Attached to the dining area is a 24sqm covered deck which is home to a Pool table, a small kitchenette and a dart board. Another BBQ facility is situated near the fish pond.

There is a large fish pond below the pool deck area with a small viewing deck featuring both views of the river and mountains. Below this area is a large unused section of the property with another building needing some renovation and available for someone's dream to be realized. The property is undergoing rezoning which is in the final stages and almost completed. This new zoning will allow much more opportunity, such as sectional title and more apartments or chalets to be erected plus more options to be explored.

There are many attractions in the area that attracts visitors from inland as well as international. For the golf enthusiast, there are 8 renowned golf courses all in close proximity. Several hiking trails in the area waiting to be explored, the most popular being inside the Umtamvuna Nature Reserve.



The Wild Coast Sun hotel is within 10 minutes' drive which has a Casino and many attractions for children and adults. A large water park is also found here.

The Umtamvuna River is the star attraction and has riverboat cruises, water sports and bar and restaurant facilities. To access this would be a 5-minute drive or access from the Casino and hotel.

There is currently no marketing being done besides using booking channels. A website linked to the property shows facility info and guest reviews. Some additional marketing will benefit profitability

ABOUT THE AREA

Umtamvuna View Cabanas is located on the outskirts of the popular small coastal Town of Port Edward, Several activities in close proximity are the many golf courses, Wild Coast Casino, Wild waters theme park, Beaver Creek coffee farm and the Umtamvuna river water activities, restaurants and sight seeing.

Port Edward is a small resort town situated on the south coast of KwaZulu-Natal in South Africa. It lies north of the Mtamvuna Gorge which includes the Mtamvuna River and is the border between KwaZulu-Natal and the Eastern Cape. It is situated on the R61 road between Port Shepstone and Lusikisiki.

The area includes Palm Beach, Glenmore and Leisure Bay. This is a pristine coastal area, which has natural attraction of the like of the Mpenjati Nature Reserve.

The first holiday cottage in Port Edward was a shack built among the sand dunes in the early days by transport rider Edward Stafford. Unaware of their motility, however, he was surprised and dismayed to see his fine creation swallowed up. The area was subjected to several name changes as property was bought and sold, but the practice came to an end in 1952 when the town of Port Edward was ceremoniously dedicated to the then Prince of Wales.
